- 3. If you choose to cut and paste data from another area, use the PASTE SPECIAL option and select VALUES. This will protect the current formats.
- 4. Each cell in the 618 Data Pre-submission Edit Check Tool contains a "-9" value by default. If your state will not report that data element, leave the "-9" as a placeholder. Only enter "0" for true zero counts.
- 5. RED cells indicate computational errors or an error in reporting. Please make sure there are NO RED CELLS before saving data.
