

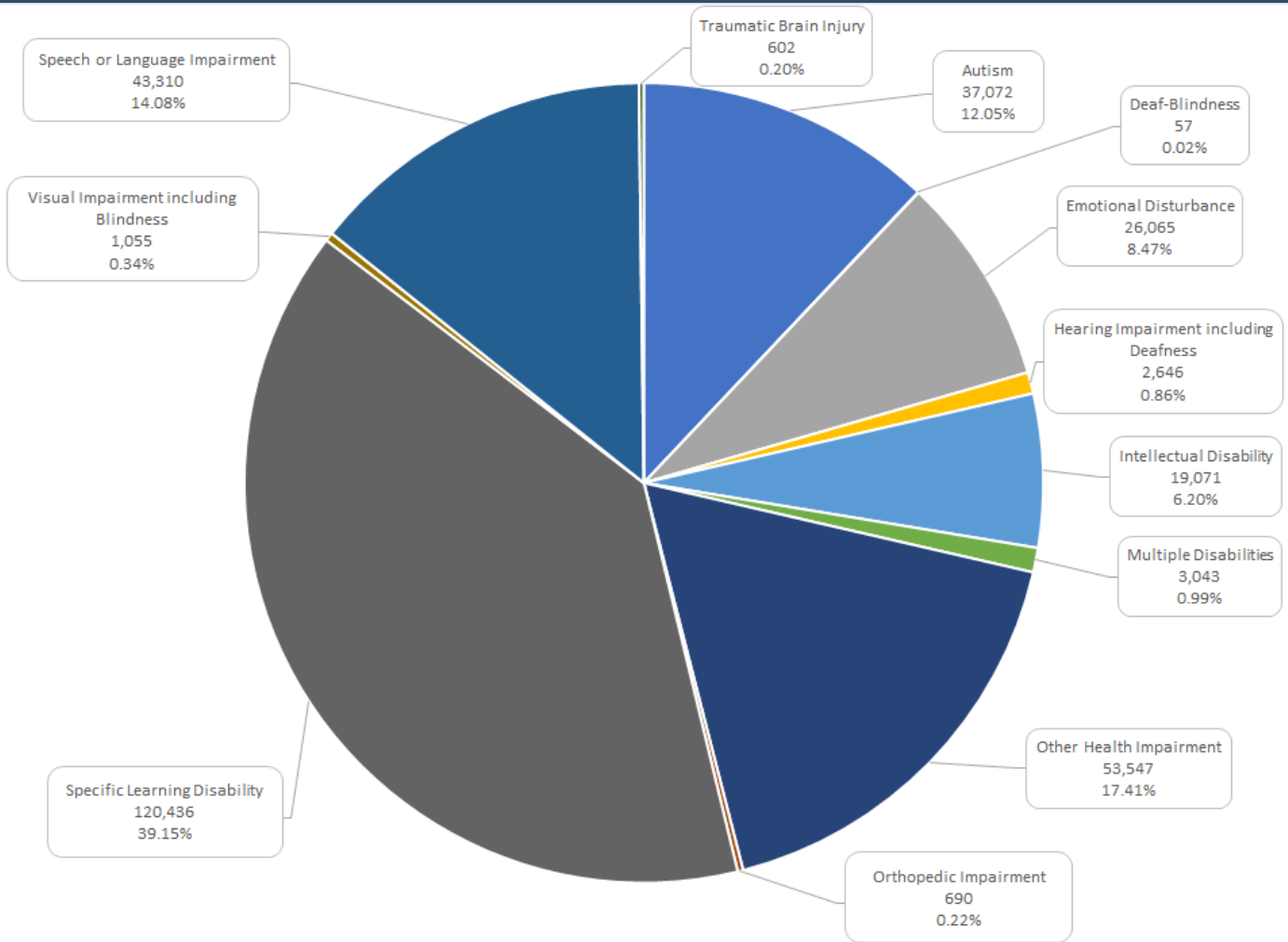

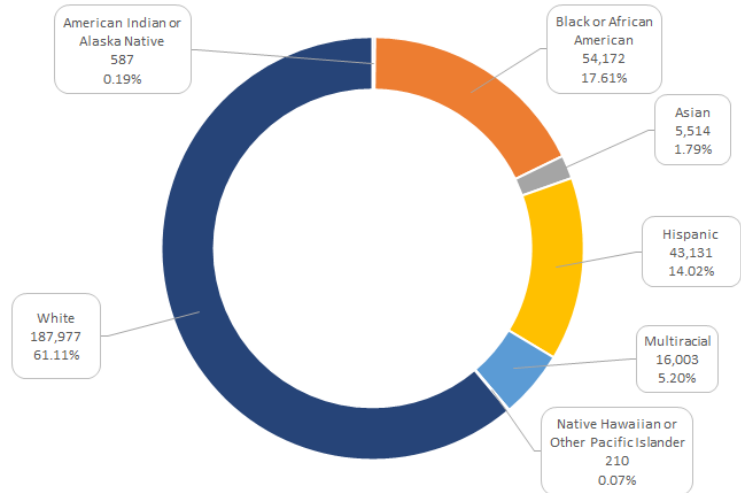

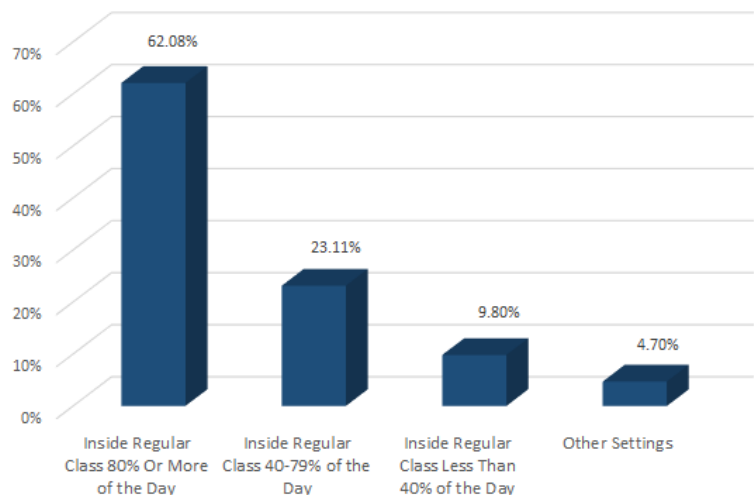
Special Education Enrollment for School Age Students by Race/Ethnicity
